



## 2007– 08 FCCLA State Program of Work

- **Amp Up Your Membership**
  - Be enthusiastic and recruit new members to explore their potential leadership skills. The Executive Council recommends increasing Colorado membership by fifteen percent.
  - Energize and retain members by staying active. The Executive Council recommends participating in chapter projects and STAR Colorado Events.
  - Encourage individuals and chapters to gain recognition. The Executive Council recommends applying for at least one Colorado FCCLA award or scholarship.
- **Take Your Leadership Platinum**
  - Increase leadership involvement. The Executive Council recommends members run for office at the chapter, district, state and/or national level.
  - Become a dynamic leader by developing pride and building character. The Executive Council recommends becoming involved in the national FCCLA program, *Dynamic Leadership*.
  - Be a positive role representative of your school community. The Executive Council recommends developing a *Power of One* project for the "Taking the Lead" unit.
- **Harmonize Your Role in the Global Community**
  - Increase your service near and far, within your community and on a global level. The Executive Council recommends participating in the Colorado Service Project, "Raise Your Voice to Give Them Thanks."
  - Decrease violence in your school and community by accepting diversity in everyday life. The Executive Council recommends participating in the *STOP the Violence* national program.
  - Make healthy choices that impact you as an individual, your family, and your community. The Executive Council recommends participating in the *Student Body* national program.
